Through her work, she aims to inspire adventures in the Great Outdoors and encourage others to live their most fulfilling life, "the big Life with a capital L," with or without a camera in hand. Her work has graced the pages of publications such as *National Geographic*, *Arizona Highways*, *AAA Via*, *On Landscape*, *National Parks Traveler*, and a broad variety of other outlets. She has penned several award-winning books, including "Wild in Arizona: Photographing Arizona's Wildflowers," "The Current Flows: Water in the Arid West," and "Photographing Acadia National Park: The Essential Guide to When, Where, and How" (after serving thrice as Acadia's Artist-in-Residence). Her first adventure travel memoir, "So Said the River: Life, Loss, and Pie on the Colorado," was published in July 2024. She writes an online photography advice column called "Dear Bubbles." She leads photography workshops (including all-women sessions called Sheography™), teaches classes, and offers one-on-one mentoring.
